MARSHALING & RACING PENALTIES

Below are taken from the BRCA handbook.

RACING

For the likes of bad driving i.e Taking people out Not letting the fast car through when told by the ref Track cutting

Taken from rule 17.6

There will be the following steps. The first offence will be a warning as to not to do it again the second time will be a 10 sec penalty on you best time of the day and if the ref has to tell you a 3rd time then it will result in disqualification.

The above procedure will be the same for poor marshalling.

MARSHALING

Taken from rule 17.11 & 17.12

If you are late to your marshal point (not on your place by the time the first car sets off) then 7 places will be added onto you best score. If you do not marshal at all and do not get someone to cover your spot then you will lose your best round score.

EXIT AND ENTER THE ROSTRUM

Taken from rule 17.13 & 17.14

Competitors entering or exiting the rostrum while a QUALIFYING race is in progress then you will have 7 places added onto your best score. (No warning)

Competitors entering or exiting the rostrum during a FINAL race will get 7 places added onto your overall position.

I believe that bringing these rules to your attention will stop what has gone on in previous meetings.

Please respect the ref's decision and respect the rules/penalties set by the BRCA.
